Rifles: Match Rifles and Service Rifles are used, the most popular are AR-15, M-1A, and M-1. No muzzle breaks.

Equipment: Bring at least 100 rounds. Eye, ear protection, and Open Chamber Indicators (loaners available) are required. Spotting scopes, shooting jackets, gloves, and mats are helpful.

Awards: Awards will be given for grand aggregate match winner and individual matches (offhand, sitting, prone rapid, prone slow) per classification. Classifications with less than 3 shooters will be bumped up to the next classification for awards.
