

Reduced Palma Match

This match is designed to be fun for all levels of shooters, from the best around to beginners. Beginners are most welcome. We do provide instruction and assistance to beginners. We fire four categories:

Match Rifle, Service Rifle, ie, Iron Sights with Sling

“F” Class Target Rifle (F-TR) , “F” Class Open Rifle (F-O), ie, Scoped with Bipod



Course of Fire: sighting in (10 min for unlimited number of sighting shots), then three strings of 15 rounds each at an MR-63 or MR-63F from 300 yd in a time of 20 min each. All from prone position. Bring at least 65 rounds: 45 for record, 20 for sighting in. We place a “Shoot-N-C” over the MR-63 targets to make the bullet hits more visible. And we have a great time doing it all. As per NRA Rules, muzzle brakes are not allowed. Open Chamber Indicators, eye, and ear protection are required.

Range: # 6

When: 3rd Saturday of the month

Arrival Time: 6:45 - 7 AM

First Shot: 8 AM. Competition is completed by Noon.

Awards: the top shooter in each category of a minimum of three shooters is eligible for an award, experience level can also be considered for an award.
