A Message from the SBRGC President

South Bay Rod & Gun Club is still working to keep up with rapidly changing regulations and orders regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19). For the most up to date information, please visit the club's home page at: www.sbrgc.org which will indicate when things change. As a Club, it is our intent to keep our members and the public safe.

Wearing of Masks is mandatory when you are within 6' of another individual. When you are shooting at your assigned spot you can relax your wear of the mask if you so choose, but once you depart your shooting spot you need to have the mask on. This allows others to move more freely behind the red firing line. RSO's will be enforcing this rule as it is intended to keep everybody safe from spreading the virus from one individual to another individual.

Some questions have come up with respect to the upper ranges (Range 1, Range 2, & Range 3).

What can be shot on the ranges? Each Range can handle a projectile from 50 CAL and on down. This is based on the design of the side berms and the backstop material/depth.

Can I shoot Rifles on Range 1 and Range 2? The answer is yes but it adds a safety issue that must be carefully watched. The tables are designed for Pistol (only 30" deep) and do not properly support a rifle when its placed on the table with a portion hanging over the front and a portion hanging over the back in order to keep the muzzle pointed down range. Placing the rifle crosswise on the table is a major safety violation.

Can I shoot Pistol on Range 3? The answer is yes but it adds a safety issue. The tables are designed to hold a rifle, pointed with the muzzle down range. When using a handgun, the user must stand between the tables to bring the muzzle forward of the red painted firing line. This creates the safety issue when the person needs to set the pistol/revolver down as the table is to their right or left and have a tendency to turn toward the table but in doing this will cause an unsafe condition when the muzzle's down range direction is not maintained.

Can I shoot steel Targets on Range 1 and Range 2? Yes, but special steel rules will apply:

- Steel targets must be at 25 yards or greater from the firing line
- Only pistols in pistol calibers and/or rifles with pistol calibers can be used at the steel targets
- Steel target guidelines must be followed from the Standard Operating Procedure, (SOP).

Can I shoot steel targets on Range 3? Yes, but special steel rules will apply.

- Steel targets must be at 25 yards or greater from the firing line for pistol in pistol calibers and rifles in pistol calibers.
- Steel targets must be 100 yards for pistols in rifle calibers and rifles in rifle calibers.
- Steel target guidelines must be followed from the Standard Operating Procedure, (SOP).

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following main projects:

- ⇒ Range Water System. Water well permit modifications has been submitted to the county and we are currently waiting for response. If approved we will be working on the water system installing a filter system at each sink. More news to come once the county responds.
- ⇒ Range Complex Hazmat Assessment is being conducted to determine if each item is standard waste or meets the criteria for hazmat waste.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on Oct 3, 2020 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the Range and Ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food and desert. Start time 7:30. Social Distance rules will be followed so bring your mask. Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ◆ Tree/Weed trimming at the Ranch
- ◆ Welding on the Sales Enclosure & repair of some target stands.
- ◆ Tractor work at the Range (maintenance yard) & Ranch (ground clearing & back fill of the sewer trench).
- ◆ Concrete work around sewer cleanouts at the Ranch (Setting forms and pouring concrete)
- ◆ Cleaning of the maintenance yard in preps for some road base material
- ◆ Shooting Table Refurbishment by Quonset Hut
- ◆ Number board refurbishment by Quonset Hut
- ◆ Level 40' Container on Trap Range
- ◆ Repair phone wiring on Range 2
- ◆ Setting up the maintenance yard as we start to close down the Quonset Hut work zone.
