# NRA HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCH



High Power is a really fun Match where you get to fire three different positions, and rapid fire from two of them. Not a dull moment! The challenge is all against yourself to try your best, whatever that is. If you seek to improve your skills, we help you. The Match is NRA Approved, meaning that you can earn NRA Classifications (see below). Most choose not to, but if one wishes to compete to

earn the National title of Distinguished Rifleman (see below) this Match prepares you. Whatever is your pleasure, this Match always provides a good day at the

range!



We begin our Match firing 20 rounds Off Hand at targets 200 yards down range.



Then we fire Sitting Rapid Fire in two strings of 10 rounds each from 200 yards.



Third, we fire Prone Rapid Fire in two strings of 10 rounds each from 300 yards.



Last, we fire Prone Slow Fire 20 rounds at 300 yards. Sometimes, we win an award!

Any	5 sighting shots, 5 minutes time limit	200 yd	SR
Offhand	20 shots, 20 minute time limit	200 yd	SR
Sitting Rapid	2 each 10 shots, 60 second time limit	200 yd	SR
Any	5 sighting shots, 5 minutes time limit	300 yd	SR 3
Prone Rapid	2 each 10 shots, 70 second time limit	300 yd	SR 3
Prone Slow	20 shots, 20 minute time limit	300 yd	MR-63

## **Additionally:**

1. Magazine changes are required during the Rapid Fire strings, two magazines are required.

- 2. Muzzle brakes are not allowed.
- 3. Open Chamber Indicators, eye, and hearing protection are required.
- 4. We use "ShotMarker" electronic targets. Bring Android, iPhone, or iPad for your own display device.
- 5. The SBR&GC NRA High Power Rifle Match is NRA Approved allowing Shooters to earn an NRA Classification.
- 6. Awards are given for skill level.
- 7. While the Match is intended to be an individual challenge, it is also an

environment where shooters help each other and have a very enjoyable and rewarding experience.
