Match Rifle, Service Rifle with sling, and metallic or optical sights (4.5x max magnification and max objective lens diameter of 34 mm).

"F" Class Target Rifle (F-TR), ie, *Scoped with Bipod, .308 or .223 cal

"F" Class Open Rifle (F-O), ie, *Scoped with front rest, \leq .35 cal

Electronic Targets: we use **"ShotMarker**". **Bring** your **Android**, **iPhone**, **iPad** for a read-out display device.

Course of Fire: Sighting in, then three strings of 20 rounds each for record. Each string for record is preceded with the option to fire sighting shots. Time limits: first string 10 minutes for unlimited sighters, then 20 minutes for 20 rounds for record, second and third strings 2 minutes for 2 sighters, 20 minutes for 20 rounds for record. All strings for record are fired at an MR-63 or MR-63F from 300 yd. All shooting is from the prone position and we have a great time doing it all. As per NRA Rules, muzzle brakes are not allowed. Open Chamber Indicators, eye, and hearing protection are required. We may have multiple relays depending on attendance and available electronic targets, and requirements for barrel cooling.

Ammunition: Match ammo recommended. Bring at least 80-85 rounds: 60 for record, 20 for sighting in.

Awards: the top shooter in each category of a minimum of three shooters is eligible for an award, experience level can also be considered for an award.
