Range Layout

Range layout will be as follows:

Target line: The target line will be set up at the normal 100 yard line, as measured from the conventional firing line. Target frames, sticks, and numbers will be established in even intervals, with a maximum of 32 points, aligned with the firing points on the conventional firing line.

Firing Lines: Distances referenced during the match will be measured from the target line to the firing line.

7 yard line: The closest firing line used. The line will be marked on the range floor. Shooters will take their firing position 7 yards from the targets, and aligned centered between the two targets they will address.

- Shooter #1 will be aligned between Target 1-2, shooter #2 will be aligned between Target 3-4, shooter #3 will be aligned between Targets 5-6, etc.
- This will place them in the optimum position to fire upon both targets.
- No barricades at this distance. Address targets per the course of fire.

15 yard line: Firing line will be marked on the range floor. Shooters will take their firing position 15 yards from the targets, and aligned centered between the two targets they will address. No barricades at this distance. Shooters will address targets per course of fire.

30 yard line: Firing line will be marked on the range floor. Barricades will be set up at the 30 yard line, with one barricade centered between each pair of targets. 1-2; 3-4; 5-6, etc. Shooters will address their targets from immediately behind, or adjacent to the barricades per the course of fire.

60 yard line: Firing line will be marked on the range floor. After firing is completed at the 30 yard line by all participants, the barricades will be carried back and placed in similar fashion at the 60 yard line. Shooters will address their targets from immediately behind, or adjacent to the barricades per the course of fire.

100 yard line: After firing is completed at the 60 yard line by all participants, the barricades will be carried back and placed in similar fashion at the 99 yard line. Shooters will address their targets from immediately behind, or adjacent to the barricades per the course of fire.
