A Message from the SBRGC President

The Club's Annual Banquet Dinner is this month, specifically on February 22, 2020 at Viejas Casino (Same Place as last year). Contact Bailey Hom (CRSO) to get your name on the reservation list. Information is available on the web page calendar. This year you will be required to check in to get your wrist band which will get you access to the banquet hall.

PLEASE NOTE: the February board meeting has been moved to Denny's at 2691 Navajo Rd, El Cajon, CA 92020.

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following main projects:

1. New well for the range complex and upgrades to the water system.
 - a. The Club continues working to set aside enough capital to drill the well and do the connections from the well location to the current water system but we continue to get setbacks in funding and water issues that keep cropping up that hinder the process. (water leaks in the old system that require repair on the spot)
 - b. The proposed new well location will be up near range 1.
2. During the phases there will be some dirt work around range 1, a trench from the new well to the restroom. This will affect traffic when its open (we can't close it until the county inspects the pipe in the trench).
 - a. We are just about done modifying the water building to accommodate the new well and it should be complete by the end of March. This project is about 85% complete.
3. Water system (ranch) refurbishment: in progress.
 - a. Replacing some conduit and water piping for the new water building at the ranch
4. The two sump drains (Range 2 and Range 3) are complete.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on February 1st and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the range and ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food. Start time is 7:30. (Note: range 2 will be closed for a photo shoot)

Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ◆ Troubleshoot/Repair of water line between range 5 and range 3. We will be exposing the water pipe on the road near range 3 to help localize the leak.
- ◆ Work on the water building on the range complex.
- ◆ Incorporating the piping for the new well (when drilled).
- ◆ Expansion of the back-flow prevention device by the booster pump building to separate the potable from the non-potable systems.
- ◆ Tree/Weed trimming at the ranch
- ◆ Continued welding work on the enclosure for ammo cans, brass sales and rifle rest stowage and repair of some target stands.
- ◆ Continued work on removal of building 2 at the ranch
- ◆ Drainage rework for range 6 parking lot
- ◆ Maintenance yard setup (starting to move in)
- ◆ Tractor work at the ranch for ground clearing and back fill of the sewer trench.
