UPCOMING WORK PARTIES MARCH 4TH & APRIL 1ST

Some of the scheduled range work includes:

- Weeds on R6 (Range will be closed)
- ⇒ Weeds on top of 100-yard berm
- ⇒ Weeds on top of 200-yard berm
- ⇒ Weeds around number boards
- Orange Barricades for all ranges (R1, R2, & R3) Empty the orange barricades and distribute
- Modify Gate (Welding preps for new install) and install on west end of Maintenance Yard
- Level the 40' container on R5
- Fence old gate hole with barbed wire (4 strands)
- Fix Target Line (50 Yd), 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12 (Range)

Some of the scheduled ranch work includes:

- Fence Lot "A" backyard (Install 24-line posts)
- Install a box with outlet in the South end of maintenance yard container
- Wire container with lights and outlet (Ranch)
- Form & pour concrete curbs for power/data pull boxes south of Lot D
- Determine Utilities Connection Location on Lot 3, (Sewer, Water & Power)

1. Youth Marketing Ban (LA Area): The amendment was signed and the Junior Program is back up and running, however there is still major issues with this youth marketing ban and the challenge continues in the court system.

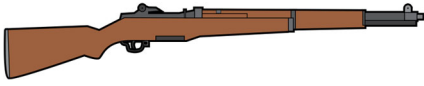
In only his second time firing with us, Jeremy Belk came in 2nd F-TR. Jeremy will return this summer to shoot with us again and we anticipate more good things from him then.

Getting the Best Out of Your Service Rifle?



We will be holding training sessions with emphasis on trigger time at the firing points. We will have highly experienced coaches to provide guidance for the attendees.

You will learn the basics of proper aiming, sighting in at any distance, and wind calls. Then, removing the shooting tables, you will learn how to shoot from the basic positions of Standing, Sitting, and Prone.
