#### **A Message from the SBRGC President**

#### CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE UPDATE REGARDING LARGE CAPACITY MAGAZINES

On August 14, 2020, a three-judge panel of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed the district court decision in *Duncan v. Becerra*. The appellate ruling does not lift the stay that California Attorney General Xavier Becerra secured at the commencement of the appeal. The stay remains in place until the appellate process is final. This allows California's nearly twenty-year-old prohibition on the acquisition of new large capacity ammunition magazines to remain in effect pending further appellate proceedings. In California, it has been illegal since 2000 to manufacture, import, keep or offer for sale, give, lend, or receive large-capacity magazines—defined as those that can hold more than 10 rounds of ammunition.

On March 29, 2019, the District Court for the Southern District of California ruled that this law was unconstitutional. Attorney General Becerra asked the judge to stay his ruling pending appeal to prevent the influx of large-capacity magazines into the state while litigation is ongoing. This request was granted. As a result, as of 5:00 p.m. on April 5, 2019, California Penal Code section 32310(a) and (b) went back into effect and they remain in effect until further action by the appellate court: "(a) Except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 32400) of this chapter and in Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 17700) of Division 2 of Title 2, any person in this state who manufactures or causes to be manufactured, imports into the state, keeps for sale, or offers or exposes for sale, or who gives, lends, buys, or receives any large-capacity magazine is punishable by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year or imprisonment pursuant to subdivision (h) of Section 1170. "(b) For purposes of this section, 'manufacturing' includes both fabricating a magazine and assembling a magazine from a combination of parts, including, but not limited to, the body, spring, follower, and floor plate or end plate, to be a fully functioning large-capacity magazine."

Wearing of Masks is mandatory when you are within 6' of another individual. When you are shooting at your assigned spot you can relax your wear of the mask if you so choose, but once you depart your shooting spot you need to have the mask on. This allows others to move more freely behind the red firing line. RSO's will be enforcing this rule as it is intended to keep everybody safe from spreading the virus from one individual to another individual.

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following main projects:

- Range Water System. Water well permit modifications has been submitted to the county and we are currently waiting for response. If approved we will be working on the water system installing a filter system at each sink. As it sets right now there is not enough time to drill the well and complete all the testing required to allow a new well to be connected to our existing system by the end of Sep 2020. (More news to come once the county responds)
- Range Complex Hazmat Assessment

- ◇ Tree/Weed trimming at the Ranch
- ◇ Welding on the Sales Enclosure & repair of some target stands.
- ◇ Tractor work at the Range (maintenance yard) & Ranch (ground clearing & back fill of the sewer trench).
- ◇ Concrete work around sewer cleanouts at the Ranch (Setting forms and pouring concrete)
- ◇ Cleaning of the maintenance yard in preps for some road base material
- ◇ Electrical work on the Well at the Ranch
- ◇ Shooting Table Refurbishment by Quonset Hut
- ◇ Setting up the maintenance yard as we start to close down the Quonset Hut work zone.
