***A Message from the SBRGC President***



### **NOTICES**

1. There is a Table Top Sale at the VFW Hall in Lemon Grove, 22 Aug 2017. Doors open at 6:30 and will start at 7:00.
2. At the BOD meeting on 7/12/2017 the operating hours for the range complex were reviewed and effective 8/1/2017 the weekday hours (Monday through Friday) will change to 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM year around. Summer hours (June 1 - Aug 31) of 8:00AM to 5:00PM will remain in effect for weekends (Saturday and Sunday).

**Firearms Laws** - A federal judge in San Diego (U.S. District Judge Roger Benitez) has blocked the California law set to take effect on July 1, 2017 that would have barred gun owners from possessing high-capacity ammunition magazines. The judge ruled that the ban approved by the legislature and voters last year takes away gun owners' Second Amendment rights and amounts to the government taking people's private property without compensation. California law has prohibited buying or selling the magazines since 2000, but until now allowed those who had them to keep them.

California Department of Justice (DOJ) submitted their definition of what an Assault Weapon is but that was rejected by the Office of Administrative Law. Governor Jerry Brown extended the assault weapon registration period until July 1, 2018. Stay tuned for new updates.

**Notice to RSO's** - A highlighted copy of the New SOP has been placed in the Range 6 RSO building for your review. The areas that have been changed from the last SOP are highlighted in Yellow. The new version is also available for download on our website at <http://sbrgc.org/Standard-Operating-Procedures>.

Range 6 has a new gate installed. This gate is to be closed during live fire to prevent members/guests from going forward of the red line during live fire. Failure to close the gate may put members/guests in danger. Electrical Upgrade (In progress) - The electrical contractor still has to install the Meter/Power panels. Once complete it will be turned over to SDG&E/ATT for wire installation. Range to be closed during the wire install. Watch the web site for details as they become available.

**We Need Range Safety Officers!** There is a new link on the SBRGC web page for personal to become Range Safety Officers, Just select the link, fill in the details and the CRSO or ACRSO will contact you. If you are at the Range just ask a RSO for a RSO package. A SBRGC RSO has benefits:

- ◆ Key to the range
- ◆ You can open a range by yourself for your usage. (As per the SOP)
- ◆ Once you serve one year (As per the SOP) your membership is free as long as you continue to serve
- ◆ Annual Dinner that the club pays for dinner tickets for you and a guest
- ◆ Only one duty day a month (Your Choice) however we prefer that you pick days where we have shortages

## South Bay Rod & Club's CMP Program

will hold Matches on September 30<sup>th</sup> and October 29<sup>th</sup>.

They will be 100yd Centerfire Rifle Matches designed for people who want to learn Highpower rifle shooting competition – but don't know where to start. It is also for those who wish to purchase a M1 Garand from the Civilian Marksman Program (CMP).

The CMP now allows "Highpower Alternative Rifles". This allows competitors in states (like California) where the ownership or possession of M16/AR-type rifle is prohibited, to use a rifle that has the same capabilities as an M16/AR-type rifle. Alternative Rifles may be either semi-auto or manually operated and must be chambered for the 5.56 x 45mm NATO cartridge (.223). Optical sights with a manufactured maximum of 4.5 X 34mm are permitted. These rifles must have a 4.5-pound trigger pull, a maximum barrel length of 20 inches and a fixed sling swivel on their fore-ends. Alternative Rifles may have stocks with the same adjustment capabilities as Service Rifles, that is butt-stock length may be adjustable, but the cheek-piece and butt-plate must be fixed. Stock design and magazine configuration is flexible according to what is permitted in the competitor's state.

On a personal note - it's time for us Californians to get out and exercise our 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Right! This right is being eroded almost daily! You should try and get some use out of that CA Assault Rifle, before you are forced to surrender it to the State!!

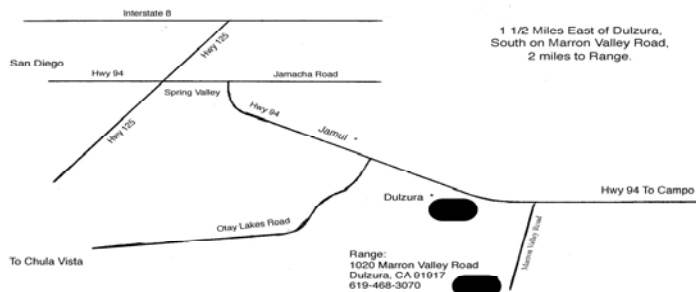
