We need Range Safety Officers

We are looking for club members interested in becoming Range Safety Officers and Trap Range Safety Officers. Basic safety indicates that we need more than one RSO on a given range and some ranges require more than two RSO's. With five active ranges, we have many open spots to fill. When you become a SBRGC RSO there are benefits:

1. Key to the range
2. You can open a range by yourself for your usage.
3. Once you serve one year (As per the SOP) your membership is free as long as you continue to serve.
4. Annual Dinner that the club pays for your dinner tickets for you and a guest.
Only one duty day a month (Your Choice) However we prefer that you pick days where we have shortages.

Property Development:

Range - "K" Rails have been installed in the middle and along the outer edge to help control parking on range 6. The next big project is the removal of the water tank on the south west area of the parking lot. This tank will be relocated to the Ranch to replace an older water tank.

Ranch - Demolition of the walls in the Ranch House (Future Club House) continues.

Work party notice: The work party for Feb 4th is scheduled and you are invited to attend. Some of the projects scheduled include: continued work on the phone system; work on the interior demo of the club house on the ranch; welding on target stands,; cleaning the "K" rails for painting; power on Range 1 as well as other small projects. The more members who attend the more jobs get done.

Firearms Laws: California Department of Justice (DOJ) is in the process of defining what the legislators passed and what the voters passed in Prop 63. Once the process is complete, they will publish these for review. Currently they have submitted an Emergency Magazine Ban definition but it was pulled for later submission due to some procedural errors and the Assault Weapons laws was submitted on Dec 29, 2016 and is still under review.

- New defined assault weapons registration period from Jan 1 to Dec 31, 2017. Recommend that anybody who has these to wait until the dust settles (Jun/Jul) before you jump on this. This law focuses on the AR/AK style firearms that were using the bullet button as a work around from the original Assault Weapon law from 2000, (Category 3 Assault Weapons). The new defined assault weapons will be Category 4 Assault Weapons. (CA-DOJ current submission has the Bullet Button remaining on the gun, which has been challenged by CRPA). You will have all of 2017 to register them on DOJ web page, make them featureless firearms and not register or remove them from the state. Current web address for California DOJ. <https://oag.ca.gov/firearms> (Note the information about the new law which is still on hold as of 1/12/2017)

Featureless firearms definition is a semi-automatic, center fire detachable magazine type fire that has all

these items removed: Pistol Grip, Thumbhole Stock, Folding or Telescoping Stock, Grenade Launcher, Flash Suppressor and Forward Pistol Grip.

- Magazine Ban - July 1 2017. Nobody except Law Enforcement/retired Law Enforcement may possess magazines that hold over 10 rounds. These must be removed from the state, destroyed or given to law enforcement/gun shops.
- Ammunition Restrictions - Jan 1, 2018 is when this takes effect. The state needs time to get the program operational with getting dealers licensed and the background check program operational. The program will check two things (Your name **is not** on the prohibited person list and your name **is on** the (AFS) Automated Firearms System). The AFS system means that you own firearms in the state that you did a background check on, (ie California firearms registration system). Note if you transferred any long guns prior to 1 Jan 2014 they are not registered in the AFS system by make, model or serial # (ie long gun registration started on 1 Jan 2014.)
- Ghost Guns - July 1, 2018. You must have state permission before you manufacture a firearm. This law is to restrict the 80% firearms or the home builds. Federal Law allows an individual to manufacture a firearm. If you go over a certain amount then you are classified as a manufacturer and must be licensed. California requires that you get permission from them before you start your home build.

I am glad to report that an enthusiastic group of 30 participants showed up at our January *America's Rifle Challenge* event. Our largest turn out to date had the range very near capacity. I can safely accommodate 34, so if your intention is to join in the fun for the February 19th program, it is advisable to be prompt in securing your spot as soon as the registration period opens on Sunday, February 12th.



Safety. Proficiency. Accuracy.

During our Feb 19th program, we will be running our first ARC Skills Test. After a group warm up, where we will shoot our standard format at the 7, 15, and 30 yard lines, we will take our normal 1/2 time break, and reconfigure the course for the Skills Test. The test will need to be performed ONE SHOOTER AT A TIME, so it will require patience on the part of all to cycle everyone through. It should take 4-5 minutes per person to run the course, so the total time required for the entire class will be something like 2.5 hours.

If you are new to the program, this might not be the best time for you to try it out, but I would encourage you to come out and watch the proceedings, and then purpose to shoot with us at the next scheduled program. Once you have read the information about the program and its requirements there, you can email me with any remaining questions at sbrgc.arc@gmail.com. We provide a great venue for you to develop your skills with your MSR (modern sporting rifle), if you don't take advantage of that opportunity, don't blame me. See you at the range.
