A Message from the SBRGC President

July 1 is the start date for two things, #1 the ban on traditional lead ammunition for hunting. The ban will apply to all hunting for all wildlife species and "in any gauge or caliber for the take of any legal species". #2 is the new background check requirement for purchasing any ammunition. {See the article on pages 4-5 for more details}

Range/Ranch Development is currently working on the following five main projects:

1. Contractor: New Power for the range – Complete
2. Contractor: New well for the range complex.
3. Work Party: Remodeling of the ranch house into the SBRGC club house. Just finished the demo of all the walls inside. It's one huge room now. (Working on designs)
4. Work Party: Water system (ranch) refurbishment: This includes a new water distribution building that will house all components of the water system (well control, tank filling control, pressure tank, chlorination system, and distribution pump). This building will also house the switch-gear for the phone system for the ranch. Currently working on the telephone, power and water lines for the water distribution building.
5. Work Party: Installing a radio link tower near the water tanks at the range to bring in high speed internet for the range complex. This will enable some upgrades to the range.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on July 6, 2019 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at the range, and at the ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food. Start time is 7:30a.m.

Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ⇒ Repairing a water leak at the range. (This has caused the water system to be shut down except for emergency operation for the restroom) We will be installing new piping from the potable tank to the restroom and the water manifold near firing point 1 on range 6.
- ⇒ Continue welding work on the enclosure for ammo cans, brass sales and rifle rest storage.
- ⇒ Continue work on the ranch water distribution building.
- ⇒ Weed trimming at the range & ranch. (thanks to all of rain this year)
- ⇒ Preparing the maintenance yard to accommodate all the functions that the quonset hut does.

We have a new Range Activity Calendar on our web page! It shows what range(s) will be available for members each day . It shows both Matches & Open Range(s) for approximately 2 weeks in advance. By being 'Live', it will be the **one and only calendar** for range availability. The BOD hopes this will reduce confusion for our members and outside contractors who want to rent ranges during the weekdays.

Ammunition: Safety Act for All 2016 (Prop 63)

The Safety for All Act of 2016 will allow ammunition to be sold only to a person whose information matches an entry in the Automated Firearms System and who is eligible to possess ammunition.

- * "Matches an entry in the Automated Firearms System, AFS". Currently when you purchase a firearm in California your name and firearm is entered into the Automated Firearms System.
 - ~If or When owner/firearm information is listed into the system depends on various dates:
 - Hand Guns registration started in Jan 1, 1969,
 - All private party sales had to go through a dealer starting in 1991 but only handguns were listed in the system.
 - Interfamily Transfers took effect in 1992 for handguns.
 - Personal Handgun Importer: If you moved into the state your hand guns had to be registered starting Jan 1, 1998.
 - Long guns registration started in Jan 1, 2014, all other long guns purchased or imported into the state before were not registered, unless they were assault weapons.
 - Note: If you acquired a firearm before these dates, the CA DOJ does not have you listed in the AFS System. If you want to find out what CA DOJ has under your name, Download BOF Form 053, Automated Firearms System (AFS) request for Firearms Records from BOF Web page.
- * Eligible to Possess Ammunition: CA DOJ maintains a Prohibited Persons List which lists people who are restricted from owning firearms and, as newly amended, includes ammunition.

Jan 1, 2018

1. Ammunition Vendors Licensing program was started by CA DOJ for Ammunition Vendors. This includes current Federal Firearms Dealers, Ammunition Manufactures or Ammunition sellers. (Turners, Redline Bullets, Walmart etc.)
2. All Ammunition Vendors employees are required to have a Certificate of Eligibility (COE).
3. Only Licensed Ammunition Vendors may sell Ammunition.
4. All ammunition must be transferred in a face to face transaction. This prohibits vendors from shipping ammunition to individuals unless the individual is licensed. Ammunition must be shipped to an Ammunition Vendor or to a exempt person/facility.
5. Expanding the current law that Prohibited Armed Persons File who cannot possess firearms to also include ammunition or reloaded ammunition.
6. Ammunition must not be accessible to the buyer. Ammunition must be behind the counter or in locked cabinets.
7. Ammunition sales by private parties must be accomplished through an ammunition vendor.
 - a. Exemptions:
 - i. A person who purchases or receives ammunition from a spouse, registered domestic partner or immediate family member.
 - ii. A person who purchases or receives ammunition at a target facility holding a business or other regulatory license, provided that the ammunition is at all times kept within the facility's premises. (This is assumed that the target facility is selling you the ammunition)
8. Makes it a crime to sell or give ammunition to a person who is prohibited or engages in a straw purchase (Purchase made by one individual for another person who is prohibited).
9. A resident of California shall not bring or transport into this state any ammunition that he or she purchased or otherwise obtained from outside of this state unless he or she first has that ammunition delivered to a licensed ammunition vendor.
 - a. Exemptions: a person who acquired the ammunition from a spouse, registered domestic partner or immediate family member. (Immediate family member means grandfather, grandmother, father, mother, son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter. All other family members are not considered as immediate)
10. An Ammunition Vendors License is required if you sell more than 500 rounds in a 30 day period.
11. A Gun Show or Event means a function sponsored by any national, state, or local organization, devoted to the collection, competitive use or other sporting use of firearms in the community. This applies to the Clubs table top sale which is held 3 times a year and a ammunition vender must be present to cover the ammunition transfers or you must see a ammunition vendor.
 - a. Sales of ammunition at a gun show or event shall comply with all applicable laws.

Ammunition: Safety Act for All 2016 (Prop 63)

July 1 2019

1. An ammunition vendor shall, at the time of delivery, record the following
 - Date of sale
 - Drivers license or other ID number
 - Brand, Type and amount of ammunition
 - Purchasers/transferee's full name and signature
 - Name of sales person who processed the sale.
 - Purchasers/Transferee's residential address and telephone number
 - Purchasers/Transferee's date of birth.
2. Information about the sale shall be electronically submitted to the CA DOJ.
 - The purchaser will be validated against the AFS System & Prohibited persons list.
3. Those that are exempt from the ammunition transfer requirements
 - a. Federally licensed C&R collectors who also possess a California Certificate of Eligibility;
 - b. Persons purchasing/receiving ammunition at a target facility holding a business or other regulatory license, provided the ammunition is at all times kept within the facility's premises; (This is assumed that the target facility is selling the ammunition and its all expended/fired at the facility) or,
 - c. Persons receiving ammunition from a spouse, registered domestic partner, or "immediate family member" (parent-child or grandparent-grandchild relationship).

According to CA DOJ there is a possibility of two fees. A \$1.00 fee and a \$19.00 fee that will be associated with the purchaser's background check.

- i. The \$1.00 fee is associated if you own one or more firearms listed in the AFS system or you have an active Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
- ii. The \$19.00 fee is associated if you have no firearms listed in the AFS system and don't have a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) (Full Scale Background Check)

Note: Up to \$1 for AFS/COE verifications and up to \$19 for full-scale background checks. According to California law, verifying the purchaser's AFS records or COE will cost no more than \$1.00 but if a full-scale background check is required, California law allows DOJ to charge "a fee not to exceed the fee charged for the department's Dealers' Record of Sale (DROS) process" which is up to \$19.00.

California law requires the background check to be completed instantly, but DOJ regulations suggest this will not be the case. California law requires DOJ to issue approval "at the time of purchase or transfer," meaning the process should be instant upon submission to DOJ. However, DOJ's most recent regulatory proposal suggests DOJ will not comply with California law in this regard. Instead, DOJ will issue "Ammunition Transaction Numbers" allowing purchasers to "monitor the status" of the background check. (This is from CRPA Ammunition memo)

DO I STILL NEED TO UNDERGO A BACKGROUND CHECK WHEN PURCHASING AMMUNITION AT A RANGE FOR USE ON THE RANGE? MAYBE. As noted above, ammunition transactions at a target facility holding a business or other regulatory license are not required to be processed by a licensed ammunition vendor as long as the ammunition is "at all times" kept within the facility's premises. But not all ranges have the necessary staff or layout to ensure the ammunition stays on the facility's premises—let alone what procedures should be followed by range personnel. Because DOJ has failed to provide any guidance on this issue thus far, many ranges may take a conservative approach in processing ammunition transactions after July 1. This means some ranges may require ammunition transactions to undergo the background check to ensure the range does not inadvertently violate California law. Note: SBRGC does not sell ammunition at present but it has been discussed. In the future when the club sells ammunition the club will do a background check for each ammunition purchaser because there is no way the club can police individuals on whether they expend/fire all the ammunition at the facility or take some home (which is a violation).

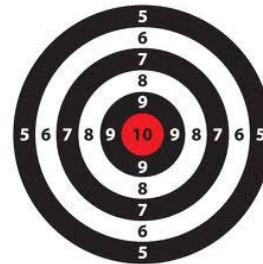

Lever Action Rifle & Long Range 22 Silhouette Match June 2, 2019

Knocking down these big and small critters is lots of fun, so if you haven't tried it, dust off that old lever gun or scoped 22LR and come on out! Bring 50 rounds of ammo – 40 for the match and 5 or 10 to sight in. 30-30 is a perfect caliber, but anything between 357Mag & 45-70 works, so long as it's safe in a tube magazine.

Course of fire is 10 rounds each: Chickens at 50 yards, Pigs at 100 yards, Turkeys at 150 yards and Rams at 200 yards. Long Range 22LR is at the same distance, except that only chickens are shot off hand, all others are from the bench.

We have FOUR matches to shoot on the third Saturday – Lever Action 22, Lever Action Pistol Cartridge, Smallbore 22 Rifle (scoped), and 22 Pistol. For the lever action matches, rifles should have a tubular magazine and may be lever action, pump or semi-auto. Other types may also be allowed upon request. Smallbore is a scoped class and is the most challenging. The 22LR pistol match has two classes, iron sights and scoped. Lever Action Pistol Cartridge is 357Mag, 32-20, 44Mag or similar.

Course of fire is the same for all matches - 10 shots each: Chickens at 40 yards, Pigs at 50 yards, Turkeys at 75 yards and Rams at 100 yards. Bring at least 50 rounds of ammo per gun – 40 for the match, some for practice and a few for tie-breakers if necessary!

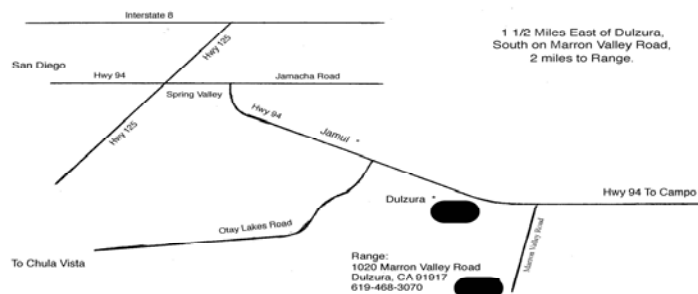
