#### A Message from the SBRGC President

A little FYI this month, the latest update from Caltrans is the work on state route 94 (SR94) curve realignment project in Dulzura is nearing completion and is expected to be finished by the end of March. Construction activities will typically continue Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and will require reducing SR-94 to one lane as needed so that crews can safely work on the closed side of the road. Motorists may be delayed for short periods as they are directed through the single open lane one direction at a time.

Another FYI pertaining to internal operations, selected club members receive a stipend for the work they do that is not associated with their elected positions. These include: Don Gussler – Range Development, Bobby Lean – Assistant Range Development, Jon Sivers – Business Manager, Bailey Hom – Chief Range Safety Officer

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following main projects:

- Water High Nitrates Issue: Some solutions under consideration include following: (Which one we do will be dependent on what the county decides) In any case each one has its price tag. (Note: It could be a combination of them.)
- \* Point of Use System at the sinks
- \* New well for the Range Complex and upgrades to the water system.
- \* Adding Well # 3 from the ranch to the current Range system
- Water leak in the line running from Range 5 to Range 3.
- Water Building (Range) Modifications: We are just about done modifying the water building to accommodate the new well and it should be complete by the end of March. (85% complete)
- Water System (Ranch) refurbishment: (80% Complete)
- Replacing water piping for the new water building at the ranch.

And of course, you're all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on Mar 7, 2020 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the Range and Ranch. Just email me at [president@sbrgc.org](mailto:president@sbrgc.org) so we can ensure we have ample food and dessert. Start time 7:30. Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ◆ Troubleshoot/Repair of water line between Range 5 and Range 3. We fix one leak and another one comes up.
- ◆ Repair of the Phone Line between Range 5 and Range 3
- ◆ Water Building (Range): Expansion of the Non-Potable Back-Flow device to include the lower pad by the main gate.
- ◆ Water Building (Ranch): Continued work on replacing piping
- ◆ Tree/Weed trimming at the Ranch
- ◆ Continued welding work on the enclosure for ammo cans, brass sales and rifle rest stowage and repair of some target stands.
- ◆ Maintenance yard setup (Starting to move in)
- ◆ Tractor work at the ranch for ground clearing and back fill of the sewer trench.

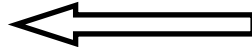

Did you notice the two scores of 200/200 in Rapid Fire Sitting? When High Power Shooters are asked

what is the favorite shooting position, they often respond Rapid Fire Sitting. Well, little wonder if they shoot their best scores sitting. For some shooters it can be their most stable position. Just check the photos. Eric Berg does very well with the knees high / open ankle position. Kevin Cooper likes the crossed legs position. See what a tight ball they become? Everything is thought through and prepared in advance. Two magazines are loaded and set on the mat. They setup their natural point of aim, and keep it through that string of firing. They breathe after each shot. As they recover from each shot and come down on their target, they retain the same sight picture. After a few Matches, it becomes perfection in motion and time.

## Lever Action Rifle & Long Range Pistol Match February 1, 2019

Knocking down these big and small critters is lots of fun, so if you haven't tried it, dust off that old lever gun or scoped 22LR and come on out! Bring 50 rounds of ammo – 40 for the match and 5 or 10 to sight in. 30-30 is a perfect caliber, but anything between 357Mag and 45-70 works, so long as it's safe in a tube magazine. Course of fire is 10 rounds each: Chickens at 50 yards, Pigs at 100 yards, Turkeys at 150 yards and Rams at 200 yards. Long Range 22LR is at the same distance, except that only chickens are shot off hand, all others are from the bench.

Smallbore is a scoped class and is the most challenging. The 22LR pistol match has two classes, iron sights and scoped. Lever Action Pistol Cartridge is 357Mag, 32-20, 44Mag or similar.

Course of fire is the same for all matches - 10 shots each: Chickens at 40 yards, Pigs at 50 yards, Turkeys at 75 yards and Rams at 100 yards. Bring at least 50 rounds of ammo per gun – 40 for the match, some for practice and a few for tie-breakers if necessary!
