A Message from the SBRGC President

We've received a lot of complaints from members regarding the poor condition of Marron Valley Road. Please understand, the club is only authorized to maintain the roads ON the club property which starts at the main gate and goes to the ranges.

The county of San Diego is responsible for Marron Valley Road and does road maintenance approximately once a quarter. The county-maintained road starts at Hwy 94 and goes to the Otay Truck Trail junction which is south of the main gate approximately one-half mile. One area that fails to get attention during maintenance is the area south of the delivery gate and before the main gate. The maintenance crew appears to skip this section for some reason. As a matter of fact, we have already had three vehicles roll over in that area.

The people who travel Marron Valley Road are local residents, Boarder Patrol, off roaders headed to BLM area, and patrons of the club. During the month of August 2019, attendance was down and there was still 2464 shooters who used the road to get to the range. So over a period of a quarter (90 days), that is approximately 14,000 trips down Marron Valley Road. Meaning, the county maintains the road after every 14,000 vehicles have used the road.

When the county is done with the maintenance, a majority of the road is in good repair of which you can travel the secondary road speed limit of 35 MPH (the residents don't like the dust so they post their own 15 MPH speed limit signs). Unfortunately, the good repair deteriorates quickly due to the amount of traffic on the road.

If you think the road should be held to a higher level of maintenance you may call the County Road Service Request: This is from the San Diego County Public Works Web Page, Report Road Problems in the Unincorporated areas of the County By calling our Hotline During Normal Business Hours, Monday – Friday 8am to 5pm. (877) 684-8000 Toll-Free or 1-858-694-3850.

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following three main projects:

- 1) New well for the Range Complex. (Club is setting aside funds for new well)
- 2) Water System (Ranch) refurbishment: Installation of well control, tank filling control, pressure tank, chlorination system, distribution pump and some electrical conduit/water lines. The building will also contain for the phone system.
- 3) Radio link tower near the water tanks at the Range to bring in high speed internet. This will enable some electronic upgrades to the range.

The range water system repair has three areas of work in progress as well:

- ⇒ Installation of a maintenance box at the low end of R3 for the water valves.
- ⇒ Rework the drain from the sink on R2 for proper flow.
- ⇒ Installation of a Back-Flow prevention device by the Booster Pump Building.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on October 5, 2019 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the range and ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food. Start time 7:30. Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ◇ Electrical work in the maintenance yard. (Power panel hookup)
- ◇ Sewer line installation at the ranch (Excavator will do the digging)
- ◇ Drain line installation on Range 2 (Excavator will do the digging)
- ◇ Relocate the radio tower to the installation site by the fire tanks.
- ◇ Continued welding work on the enclosure for ammo cans, brass sales and rifle rest stowage.
- ◇ Weed trimming at the Range & Ranch.
- ◇ Leveling the containers in the maintenance yard.

Multi-Class Silhouette Match September 21, 2019

We have FOUR matches to shoot on the third Saturday – Lever Action 22, Lever Action Pistol Cartridge, Smallbore 22 Rifle (scoped), and 22 Pistol. For the lever action matches, rifles should have a tubular magazine and may be lever action, pump or semi-auto. Other types may also be allowed upon request. Smallbore is a scoped class and is the most challenging. The 22LR pistol match has two classes, iron sights and scoped. Lever Action Pistol Cartridge is 357Mag, 32-20, 44Mag or similar.

Course of fire is the same for all matches - 10 shots each: Chickens at 40 yards, Pigs at 50 yards, Turkeys at 75 yards and Rams at 100 yards. Bring at least 50 rounds of ammo per gun – 40 for the match, some for practice and a few for tie-breakers if necessary!
