

**Conventional Outdoor Pistol Competition
NRA Approved Tournament**

Open To: Public/Open Match

Match Dates: 4th Saturday of each month, Check the Range Calendar for changes.

Firing Starts / Schedule: Match 1 starts at 8:00 AM, followed by remaining matches.

Entries:

- **Entry Fee:** Total Match Fee (Three Gun: 22 Cal, CF Cal, 45 Cal) \$25.00, 1 Gun -- \$15.00, 2 Guns -- \$20.00, 3 Guns -- \$25.00 (All Entries Must Be Accompanied By Full Payment).
- **Entries Close:** 15 Minutes before Match Starts and will be accepted to range capacity (One Relay, 30 Competitors)
- **Squadding:** All competitors will be squadded at time of check-in.

Firearms:

- **22 Cal:** Revolver or Semi-Auto Pistol, open sights or optical sights, in accordance with NRA Pistol Rules
- **Center Fire:** Revolver or Semi-Auto Pistol, open sights or optical sights, in accordance with NRA Pistol Rules
- **45 Cal:** Revolver or Semi-Auto Pistol, open sights or optical sights, in accordance with NRA Pistol Rules

Classification of Competitors: NRA classification system will be used in all matches. In the event that there are fewer competitors in each class and category they will be combined across and upwards.

Targets: All firing will be done on the approved NRA target's (B6 – 50yd) & (B8 – 25yd).

Rules: Current NRA Pistol Rules Will Apply. Rule 10.10(a) will apply.

Scoring: Competitors will score. Any competitor who does not fulfill his/her scoring duties may be disqualified.

Award Restrictions: A competitor may not win more than one award in any match. There must be a least five competitors in each class and category for a 1st place, ten competitors for a second place, fifteen competitors for a third place, twenty competitors for a fourth place and twenty-five competitors for a fifth place. The awards will be presented at the pistol range approx. fifteen minutes after completion of the last match. In the event that there are fewer competitors in each class and category they will be combined across and upwards. Awards Will be Cash per classification group (Matches 1 - 16).

General Information:

- Parking behind the firing line
- Housing and Eating facilities are not available on the range. The closest facilities are available in San Diego area.
- Participants are welcome to bring their own water containers, however, cold beverage machines are available on ranges 3 and 6.
